Camp Butterworth Extension

Located above the Little Miami River in Warren County, Camp Butterworth has been a favorite Girl Scout campsite since 1935. Each year thousands of girls and adults make use of this 160 acre site which has wooded hillsides and open fields suitable for a wide variety of outdoor activities.

Spend time at Camp Butterworth and complete two of the following activities:

1. Eco-Trail

The Eco-Trail begins behind Wagon Wheel. It has a series of activity boxes labeled 1-8. Take this hike and do the activities along the way.

2. Archery

Sign up for a three hour archery session at Camp Butterworth. Sessions are hosted in the fall and spring of each year and cost \$3/girl. Check out www.grgsc.org for availability.

3. Bike Trail

The bike trail is just around the corner from Camp Butterworth. You might consider taking a bike ride with your troop (remember to follow all *Safety-Wise* standards). Before or after your bike ride stop by camp for a picnic lunch.

4. Stay the Night

Plan an overnight campout at Camp Butterworth. If this is your first time camping you might want to start with sleeping in one of the lodges. Experienced campers might want to spend a night or two in platform tents, and the most experienced can invite a younger troop to join them on this adventure.

5. Service Project

As Girl Scouts, we always leave the place better than we found it. Doing a service project at camp can be as easy as:

- Maintaining the camp trails by picking up brush and trash
- Collecting firewood for each of the fire circles
- An older girl troop taking a younger girl troop camping

Be creative with your service project, you can always do something during your campout!
